

### CAM Applicability Flowchart

(Applicability is determined on a pollutant-by-pollutant basis for each emissions unit)

DEADLINES FOR CAM PLANS - 40 CFR 64.5	
<b>Initial Application</b> (submitted after 4/20/98)	<u>Only</u> for emission units with potential <b>post</b> -control emissions of an applicable regulated pollutant that are equal to or greater than major source thresholds. If the initial Title V application was submitted after April 20, 1998, the CAM plan is due as part of the initial application.
<b>Significant Modification</b> (submitted after 4/20/98)	<u>Only</u> for emission units with potential <b>post</b> -control emissions of an applicable regulated pollutant that are equal to or greater than major source thresholds. After April 20, 1998, CAM plans are required as part of any application for a significant modification of a Title V permit, but only with respect to those emission units for which the proposed amendment is applicable.
<b>Renewal Application</b>	For <u>all</u> emission units subject to CAM for which a CAM plan has <u>not</u> yet been submitted.
